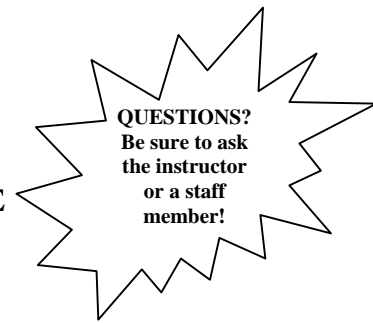


**NO LIMITS DANCE STUDIO  
RECITAL INFORMATION – ARGYLE/OAKLEAF  
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA, LAZZARO THEATRE  
SUNDAY, JUNE 14, 2009**



**GENERAL INFORMATION**

All dance classes will continue on a regular basis through June 13<sup>th</sup>. Instructors may ask you to bring your child to extra rehearsals in May and June. **June tuition is for the entire month so please make sure your account is paid in full by June 10<sup>th</sup>.** Accounts must be current for students to perform in the recital. We suggest you bring a sleeping bag, pillow, books, or some games for your child while they relax at the theatre. In addition, you may want to consider having them bring a bagged lunch/dinner or snacks, however, NO eating or drinking allowed in the auditorium or while in costume. Keep lunches/dinners, snacks and drinks outside the dressing rooms. You are not allowed to eat or drink (even water) in your costumes. Parents who are unable to be at the **University of North Florida, Lazzaro Theatre** during the day please make sure you arrange with another parent to bring your child to rehearsals! Parents are always willing to lend a helping hand. We ask you be patient with the instructors, staff, and students on this day. They have worked hard during the year in order to bring you an evening to enjoy.

**TICKET INFORMATION**

Tickets will be available April 13<sup>th</sup> at each studio. We have found that not every family uses their allotted tickets so we ask that you only take the number of tickets (up to 4 per family) you will actually need. Children age three and under will not need a ticket if they are sitting on a parent's lap. Additional tickets are available for a \$10 donation. Tickets ARE NOT be available at the door so make plans to pick up additional tickets BEFORE Sunday, June 14<sup>th</sup>.

**TECHNICAL AND DRESS REHEARSAL – NEW THIS YEAR**

**Creative Movement and Pre-School students** must be at the auditorium by 1:30 p.m. We will run the tech and dress rehearsal at the same time from 2:00 p.m. to 2:45 p.m. **Please have them in full makeup and costume by 1:30 p.m. so we can start on time.** They may leave when they have finished all their dances. They need to return to the auditorium by 5:30 p.m.

**All other students (Level 1 classes and up)** MUST be at the auditorium by 2:00 p.m. We will run the tech and dress rehearsal at the same time for these students from 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. **Please be in full make-up, costume and tights by 2:00 so we can start on time.** Once they are dressed, they MUST stay in their assigned dressing room (or other designated area). This will enable the staff to locate them promptly. In any event, students should be backstage two numbers PRIOR to their dance. Our goal is for tech and dress rehearsal to be over by 4:30 p.m. Parents can watch tech and dress rehearsal.

**AUDITORIUM SEATING**

The auditorium has asked we remind parents to leave the auditorium after dress rehearsal. Please remember no seats are to be "saved" for the performance so be sure to take all your belongings with you. Anything left in the auditorium after dress rehearsal will be gathered by the theatre staff and left backstage for pickup later. As a courtesy to our instructors, only seats for their family will be reserved. However, we do ask you to let us know if you have a family member who has special needs for seating.

**VIDEOGRAPHER**

We have again contracted with Atlantic Video to tape our recital. Atlantic Video specialized in dance recitals throughout Jacksonville. A minimum of 35 videos and/or DVD's must be sold prior to June 1st in order for parents to videotape **only their child's dance during dress rehearsal.** **Parents are not allowed to tape the entire performance.** An order form for Atlantic Video will be sent home with each

student. All checks should be made payable to Atlantic Video. You can leave the completed order form with payment to Atlantic Video at the dance studio.

### **HEAVENLY CHOCOLATE**

We have again arranged with Heavenly Chocolate to take orders for recital gifts and flower arrangements. You can arrange to pick them up yourself at the theatre or we can deliver them to your “special dancer” for you.

### **EVENING PERFORMANCE**

Students must be back in their dressing rooms by 5:30 p.m. The auditorium doors will open at 6:00 p.m. and the show will begin at 6:30 p.m. During the actual performance, students **MUST** stay in their assigned dressing rooms until they are called for their dance. **However, if you have not been called and there are only two dances PRIOR to your dance, please make sure you come backstage.** If you have a quick change (only 1 or 2 dances in-between a dance), arrange with Susan for a place to change backstage. *Creative Movement and Pre-School students may be picked up by a parent when their dance is finished.* **Level I students and up must stay in their assigned dressing rooms to prepare for the finale.** *As a professional courtesy, we ask our audience to stay for the entire show and support all the dancers in their endeavors.* The last dance of the show deserves to have an audience the same as the first dance of the show. We know it has been a long day for everyone and we have tried to make it as pleasant as possible. The faculty, staff, and students will appreciate your support.

### **FINALE**

All students (creative movement and preschool students are optional) are in the finale. This will be discussed with them during their regular classes. There could be scheduled weekend practices for finale. Please be sure to check at the studio for posted scheduled days and times OR be sure to read any paperwork your child brings home. Do not hesitate to call the studio if you have any questions.

- NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY DURING THE EVENING PERFORMANCE.
- NO VIDEO TAKING DURING THE EVENING PERFORMANCE (This will be enforced by the Florida Theatre security!) THERE WILL BE A PROFESSIONAL VIDEOGRAPHER TAPING THE SHOW.
- VIDEOTAPING DURING DRESS REHEARSAL WILL BE PERMITTED ONLY IF WE’VE MET OUR VIDEO QUOTA (35 videos).
- STUDENTS MUST **NOT** WEAR UNDERPANTS UNDER THEIR COSTUME!
- HAIR MUST BE UP AND OUT OF FACE. (Use hairspray or gel) NO BANGS OR WHISPIES!
- **NO EATING OR DRINKING (even water) IN COSTUMES!!!!**
- NO EATING OR DRINKING IN THE AUDITORIUM.
- FULL STAGE MAKE-UP. (Neutral shades of eye shadow, plenty of blush, RED lipstick, mascara, and eyeliner. Eye pencil of fair-haired children also helps.)
- TIGHTS MUST BE NEW FOR RECITAL. TIGHTS THAT HAVE BEEN WORN CAN APPEAR TO BE WASHED OUT UNDER THE BRIGHT LIGHTS. (Everyone must wear the same brand and color. A list will be provided for each dance. Tights are available at the studio through Dance N’Stuff. Please see Susan, Kristi or Mandy for purchasing your tights.)
- **DO NOT FORGET TO REGISTER FOR SUMMER CLASSES!! IT IS IMPORTANT TO KEEP DANCING THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE YEAR NOT JUST A PORTION OF IT!**
