

REMINDERS

- Be sure to write your child's name inside their dance shoes (not on the bottom). If they are left at the studio we will then know who they belong to.
- Dancers must wear a coverup when coming to and from the studio OVER their leotard.
- Ballet students (excluding Creative Movement and Pre Combo classes) must have their hair in a neat bun (with hairnet and bobby pins).




The Importance of Tap Class

Tap teaches Rhythm and Musicality - Students who take tap generally have a much better sense of musicality in their other styles of dance. In tap class, you are learning about music, how to make music, and how to listen to music. Your tap shoes are your "instrument" and the student is the "musician" playing the instrument. You will eventually find your inner rhythm and the student will have a better sense of the beat of the music.

Tap class teaches us how to count and how to listen to the music - If you understand how to listen and count music, imagine what that could do to the quality of your dancing. Tap dancing teaches basic music theory, and the better we understand the music, the better we can dance to it!

You want to be a well rounded dancer - To become an employable dancer or to succeed in a college dance program, there is a good chance that you will have to tap dance! Tap dance is a truly foundational style which can help a student further his or her understanding of dance and music.
